Guidelines for the Prevention of Head Lice

Treat the whole family.

Wash hats, coats, scarfs, bedlinen and towels.

Head lice range in size from a pin head to a sesame seed and are grey/brown in colour.

Head lice can live **detached** from hair for 12 to 24hrs.

The NHS advise that nit combing is a good preventative method to keep the lice at bay however, once a live louse has been found lotions are the most effective treatment.
