September 2018 Admissions

If you have a child born between 1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014 you need to apply now for their primary school place. You must submit one application per child, even if they already have a sibling at the school.

You can apply online from Monday 6th November at kent.gov.uk/ola

The closing date for all applications is Monday 15th January, 2018



School Meals(FSM) and Pupil Premium(PP)

Did you know, just by registering your child for Free School Meals, **even if they are in Reception Class, Year 1 or Year 2 and already receive the universal free school meals**, means our school gets extra money?

The government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families do their very best. This funding is called 'Pupil Premium'.

For every child registered, Hildenborough School receives £1320 this year. With that money we could provide more one-to-one support.
